# University Profile

## Brief Introduction of BUPT

Established in 1955, Beijing University of Posts and Telecommunications (BUPT) is directly administered by the Ministry of Education (MOE) and co-built by the Ministry of Industry and Information Technology (MIIT). It has been one of the key universities in China that has entered the national first “211 Project” and “985 Innovative Platforms for Advanced Disciplines Project”. BUPT is also a multi-disciplinary and research-oriented one with information technology as its main feature and a focus on engineering and science, offering a wide range of subjects including engineering, management, humanities and sciences for the pursuit of its coordinated development. It serves as an important talent base for China’s information technology industry.

After over six decades of development, BUPT boasts a strong academic background in information technology as well as an edge in disciplines featuring IT, two of which, namely “Information and Communication Engineering” and “Computer Science and Technology”, have been included in China’s “double first-class” list. In addition, according to results released by China’s Ministry of Education in the Fourth Round National Evaluation of Disciplinary Development in Universities, BUPT’s “Information and Communication Engineering (ICE)”, “Computer Science and Technology” and “Electronic Science and Technology” were evaluated at or above A Class, and ICE was evaluated at A+. Besides, our “Electronic Science” discipline was ranked 19th in 2020 US News Best Global Universities Rankings and “Computer Science and Technology” ranked among the Top 1% of ESI worldwide.

The university actively enhances the connection with universities for building friendly and cooperative relationships and strengthens the inter-university exchanges as the breakthrough point of the international educational exchanges, and continuously expands the cooperation with world-class universities and scientific research institutions. At present, it has established cooperative relationships with over 160 famous universities in more than 30 countries and regions, and signed nearly 300 agreements. The Confucius Institute at the University of the South Pacific has established a pattern of running schools in three countries and four regions.

The university has four campuses, namely, Xitucheng Campus, Shahe Campus, Hongfu Campus and Xiaoxitian Campus, as well as advanced research institutes in Wuxi, Jiangsu Province and Shenzhen, Guangdong Province. There are nearly 23,000 full-time undergraduate, postgraduate, doctoral and international students, and about 55,000 part-time students with full registration. International students study and live on the university’s main campus, Xitucheng area. Currently, international students come from more than 50 countries.

## Length of Study

Undergraduates at Beijing University of Posts and Telecommunications study for four years. Graduate students (Master' s Degree) study for two to three years. Graduate students (Doctor' s Degree) study for four years. Visiting students and research scholars generally stay for a year or two.

One academic year is divided into two semesters, spring and fall. The fall semester begins the new academic year, generally from September until January of the following year. The spring semester is usually from February to July. There are two long holidays every academic year, summer holiday and winter holiday. The summer holiday usually lasts for 5 weeks during July and August, when the school will arrange summer holiday courses. The winter holiday usually lasts for 4 weeks,during January and February.



## Tuition Fees

1.Application fee: 500 RMB

When sending the applications, applicants should submit 500 RMB Yuan to BUPT.(Non-Refundable)

2.Accommodation and Room Facilities

50 RMB Yuan/bed\*day

Ps. 24-hour hot water supply; Wi-Fi and air conditioner available in the dorm

3.Insurance 800 RMB/year

Health insurance is mandatory for international students.

# International Students



## Qualification of International students

1. International students must hold foreign nationality.
2. For students who are Chinese immigrants to foreign countries with one or both parents being Chinese citizens settled in foreign countries while the students themselves were born with a nationality, they must hold a valid passport or a foreign nationality certificate that proves that in the past four years, they have actually been living abroad for more than two years.

### For undergraduate programs:

The teaching language for undergraduates is Chinese except for the English program. The applicant must gain the certificate of HSK Level 4 if enrolling in the Chinese program.

### For master's programs:

The teaching language for master students is Chinese except for the English program. HSK 4 or higher level is required for Chinese-taught programs. Each applicant must provide at least two recommendation letters of experts whose title is associate professor or above.

### doctoral program :

The teaching languages for doctoral students are Chinese and English. HSK 4 or higher level is required for Chinese-taught programs. And the applicant must be provided with at least two recommendations of experts whose title is professor.

### Additional explanation:

Applicants who do not meet the above requirement for the language may be considered on an individual basis. They may first be admitted as non-degree seeking students for one academic year to study Chinese. Those who pass the examination held one year later will be automatically accepted as regular students..

## Application Time and Procedure

1.The application period is from November 1, 2023 to May 20, 2024.

2.Prepare all required documents and complete the application process on BUPT website (<https://bupt.17gz.org/>) (The original documents must be presented when applicants arrive at campus) OR mail all documents to us (Mailing address: Postbox 211, International Office, Beijing University of Posts and Telecommunications, 10# Xitucheng Road, Haidian District, Beijing, P. R. China, Postcode:100876).

3.All application materials will be reviewed by the university. Once the application is approved, BUPT will send BUPT Admission Notice and the Application Form for Students from Overseas (JW 202 Form for short) and mail the two documents to successful applicants;

4.The applicant goes in person to Chinese Embassy in his or her own country to apply for a (X) visa to study in China with the following materials: JW 202 Form, BUPT Admission Notice, Physical Examination Record for Foreigners;

5.After going through the above application procedures, the applicant shall enroll in BUPT within the time notified in the BUPT.
